


How did Mingas por el mar started?

Mingas por el Mar was created by two ocean lovers and conservationist Isabel Romero and Michael Warwick, after their first visit to Ecuador at the beginning of 2014, where they notice all the beaches they visited were full of diverse wastage and knew there was not enough information nor education about the topic. In January 2016, Cecilia Torres and her husband Ricardo Plaza offered their help to the organisation for a month, during a beach cleaning up along the coastline of Ecuador where their goal was to motivate people to take action and called the attention of citizens about this problematic issue.

As time went by there was a group of volunteers that gather which was directed by Cecilia Torres, compromise to be an example to deliver this message, educate and take action in the care and conservation of the ocean.





It is important to note that 90% of collected wastage is plastic and comes from the sea, Galgani, 2015.





Who are we as Mingas por el mar?

Mingas por el Mar is an Non-Profit Organisation that has more than 18 leaders in the coastal region, highlands and archipelago with 250 volunteers including professionals in the area of Biology, Law, Hospitality, Environmental Engineering, Education, Art and more. Compromise to be a leading example of caring about the environment to the rest of citizens to inspire the change in a variance of aspects.

We have a total of 19 active groups in Ecuador: Guayaquil, Salinas, Playas, Ballenita, Olón, Montañita, Puerto Cayo, Pedernales, Manta, Santa Cruz (Galápagos), Esmeraldas, San Pedro, Posorja, Puerto El Morro, Machalilla, Quinindé, Ancón, Ibarra y Jaramijó. What had we achieved?

Since our beginning at the end of 2015 until today, we have achieved the following:

- Consolidated **19 groups** nationally throughout of program "Leading" Volunteers".
- (\checkmark) We have done over **433 beach clean ups**.
 - Withdraw 23.200 kilos of general waste (including one use plastics wastage) in natural reserves.
 - Giving over **200 talks** about environmental education in multiple learning centres, business and communities.
